Hereby we are presenting you all the information on our common project, the Youth Exchange “Gen(d)eralisation”

About the Project

The Youth Exchange “Gen(d)eralisation” will take place in Sajan (close to Kikinda), Serbia from 17.09.2012 – 28.09.2012.

The project “Gen(d)eralisation” aims to contribute to the critical debates among young adults about the social position of men and women in South-eastern Europe. Equality, one of the preconditions for the success of democracy, is only recently present in the public discussion of the Balkan countries and represents in many parts of society still a “taboo topic”. In the frame of the international youth exchange young participants from different countries of the EU27 and Southeast European countries will deal creatively with the issue, inspired by the works of young artists and supported by them.

Content of the planned workshops are e.g. photography and movie, painting and sculpturing, theatre and graphic design. This artistic process will be accompanied by other related activities, like lectures, discussions and film screenings. Finally the artworks created by the participants will be presented to the public. In addition to the sharing of intercultural experience and intense debate of the themes the aim of this project is also to motivate the participants to become active themselves.

“Gen(d)eralisation” will gather 48 participants aged 18 till 25 coming from 8 countries. The following organisations are involved in the project:

Participation fee:

A participation fee of 20€ is taken for participating in the event. The amount is paid in cash by the participant on the spot (arrival day, registration & check in).

Travel costs

We will reimburse 70% of the travel costs for the Youth Exchange (YE) on the basis of the cheapest possibilities, e.g. second class railway tickets, APEX-flights etc. by bank transfer after the YE and the receipt of complete and original tickets, bills, receipts, boarding cards etc. Arrival day is 17th of September 2012 (later arrivals are not possible). Official departure day is the 28th of September 2012 (earlier departure times are not possible).

Please note!

1. Any costs for taxi are not eligible!
2. In case persons arriving later than 17th of September 2012 or leaving before 28th of September 2012 any related costs (e.g. for booked hostel room) will be reduced from the travel cost reimbursement.
3. Following the guide lines of the YiA programme the travel must be realized by the participants on direct way within maximum 2 days. In case of longer stays or indirect traveling (holiday travel etc.) there is no reimbursement of travel costs! Here you find the maximum travel costs for ONE participant per country from home town to Kikinda and back:

Please note!

1. The reimbursement of travel costs will happen not before all participants will have sent there complete travel documents as described above.
2. Missing tickets will not be reimbursed. Any faked tickets/documents will not be reimbursed.

About the Venue and Accommodation

Our project will be realized in Sajan, a small village next to Kikinda. You will sleep in different houses spread in the village and the activities as well as the meals will be held in the training center in the middle of the village.

IMPORTANT!!! Please bring your own towels (bed sheets will be provided).

How to arrive:

You should arrive in Kikinda, from there you will be picked up by car to Sajan.

From Belgrade airport to Belgrade city-center:

You can use the shuttle bus (**called A1**) from the airport to the Central Bus station (Autobuska stanica Beograd) in Belgrade (350 DIN one way approx. = approx 3.50 €) The Airport bus runs from the airport to the main bus station from 7:00 to 22:00 every 60 min.

Furthermore **Bus line 72** runs twice an hour to the city center and costs 120 dinars (~ €1) from the driver or 80 dinars from the shop inside the departure hall that sells food and newspapers. The trip is around 45 minutes. More Info:

From Belgrade to Kikinda: Belgrade bus-station is next to the central station in Železnička 4. It takes around 2h30 to reach Kikinda, buses are running from 6.30 a.m. to 8 p.m. (last bus!), one-way costs around 13€.

Please note to prepare for:

The Workshop “Equality in my home today”: please gather some information about the current situation of the Gender issue in your home country.

The intercultural night(s)! For being an intercultural exchange we ask you to share the traditions of your country with the other participants. No matter if you bring typical food/drink, play a scene of your history or dance to traditional music. It's up to you to represent your country the way you want to!

Safety and protection agreement

Please note the following points, which you will need **to sign** at the beginning of the Youth Exchange:

- 1) **Excessive** consume of alcohol and in accordance with Serbian jurisdiction **all** intoxicant substances are prohibited during the Youth Exchange “Gen(d)eralisation”.
- 2) All material and physical damage caused under the effect of excessive alcohol or / and intoxicant substances are not covered by the insurance of the host organisation (CGE Erfurt e. V.).

3) Noncompliance implies the non-reimbursement of back travel costs and exclusion from the program.

4) This agreement is to be signed after arriving to the Youth Exchange “Gen(d)eralisation” in Sajan.
